Our Communities




Speakers, Panels, and Workshops

Shirley had a complicated NPE. Family is of utmost importance to her and her husband Scott. Together they have six children, two grandchildren, and six grand dogs. It has taken her over twenty years of therapy, healing, an unshakable faith in God, and the encouragement of my family, and I found the courage to tell her story in "The Little Dark One." This book will give hope to the hopeless. It will help those who have questioned whether life is worth living.

Keynote Speaker

Dr. Abigail K. Hasberry

Dr. Abby describes her adoption journey as a social and mental health experiment, which she has titled Adopting Privilege. She is a family therapist associate and works with adoptees, birth moms, and young adults from a trauma-informed lens. Her work involves providing awareness of the trauma and identity confusion involved in adoption. She aims to center the voices of adoptees in the adoption narrative. Using her expertise in racial identity development and background in education, Abby has coached adult transracial adoptees and white adoptive parents of black and brown children. She's recently finished her memoir **Adopting Privilege**, which will be available in 20204.

She is a domestic trans-racial adoptee and birth parent. She was adopted as an infant and the youngest child in a family with three biological children making her not only the only adoptee, but also the only African American in her family. She is in full reunion with both her biological family and her biological son.





Dr. Everett Worthington

Dr. Worthington is a leading expert on forgiveness. After the murder of his mother in 1996 and his brother's suicide, Everett began thinking about how the practice of forgiveness relates to justice, faith, and virtue—a main theme of his recent work.




